## Work-Based Learning Program

The We Can Work Program (WCW) focuses on providing student work experiences. Student work experiences have been proven to increase employment outcomes for people with disabilities. Students must currently attend an LAUSD Career and Transition Center (CTC) to be eligible and have demonstrated a strong desire to work. The We Can Work Program is a cooperative program in partnership with the California Department of Rehabilitation. Students earn the minimum wage during paid work experiences.
