**PURPOSE:** To ensure that the federal nondiscrimination statement is included on all

program materials related to the National School Lunch and School Breakfast

**MAJOR CHANGES:** School sites develop materials regarding the National School Lunch and

School Breakfast Programs locally. All such materials must be reviewed by the assigned Area Food Services Supervisor or the site administrator to assure

that the federal nondiscrimination statement is included.

**BACKGROUND:** The National School Lunch, School Breakfast and After School Snack

Programs recently went through a mandatory audit referred to as the

Coordinated Review Effort (CRE). Forty three of the District's schools were selected for the audit. The audit found locally developed materials did not include the federal nondiscrimination statement. This citation is addressed in

this bulletin.

GUIDELINES: Criteria for Determining Procedural Changes

The authorized statement reads as follows:

"In accordance with federal law and U.S. Department of Agriculture policy, this institution is prohibited from discriminating on the basis of race, national

origin, sex, age, or disability.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** 1.

- Food Services staff will review all locally developed materials at the request of site administrators pertaining to the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs.
- 2. The site administrator should assure that the federal nondiscrimination statement is included on all program related materials.
