STATEMENT OF WORK / OVERVIEW OF SERVICES

The Los Angeles Unified School District seeks established vendors with substantial experience providing professional development to teachers, principals and administrators devised to build leadership capacity and practices that result in coherence. The "Coherence Framework" places leadership at the center to develop focusing direction, cultivating collaborative cultures, deepening learning, and securing accountability (Fullan, 2016).

In particular, the District requires access to a range of professional development tools and options to support school leaders and teachers as they improve their capacity to establishing effective leadership teams, fostering a culture of collaboration, coaching and facilitating development of clear learning goals, a process for shifting practice, ensuring access and equity via a student-centered learning model (including student aspirations, student belonging, and student learning), and creating a culture of expectation of individuals, collective commitments and responsibility. Any contract resulting from this RFP will be for the provision of professional development services concomitant with that goal.

The building Professional Development for Building School Leadership Capacity and Coherence capacity and coherence-aligned professional development will, by default, employ various modes of delivery and address the particular needs of different grade spans, content areas, and populations.
