### Implementation

- For Virtual implementation: Contractor's teachers must hold a valid CA CTC issued credential and have met subject matter competence via CSET exam (or equivalent) or coursework (ex. Via a Subject Matter Preparation Program) in the subject matter they teach:

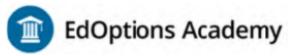
