Membership as delineated in Bylaws of May 6, 2010:

The Commission Membership shall be constituted as follows:

- 1. Key District Personnel (Ex-Officio, Non-Voting Members)
  - \*a. (1) Assistant Superintendent, Student Integration Services
  - \*b. (1) Administrator, Office of Human Relations and Educational/Instructional Equity Branch
- 2. <u>District Constituencies</u>
  - \*a. (1) Teacher (United Teachers of Los Angeles)
  - \*b. (1) Administrator (Associated Administrators of Los Angeles)
  - \*c. (1) Classified (Consensus of Unions)
  - \*d. (7) One per each member of the Board of Education
- 3. Experts, Community, Civic, Educational Equity, and Civil Rights Organizations
  - \*a. (1) Los Angeles City Human Services Department, General Manager or Designee
  - \*b. (1) Los Angeles County Human Relations Commission, Executive Director or Designee

- c. (1) Los Angeles County Office of Education, Superintendent or Designee
- d. (3) Parents/Guardians of students enrolled in the District and other than District employees. The balance of this representation will strive to include one from each level: elementary, middle school, and senior high school.
- e. (up to 7) Commission Members will reflect a range of civic, community, educational equity, and civil rights organizations.

\*These designated seats are "standing" or fixed seats on the Commission.
