The Alliance of Asian Pacific Administrators (AAPA), Association of Jewish Educators (AJE), Council of Black Administrators (COBA), and Council of Mexican American Administrators (CMAA) have joined together to sponsor scholarships for selected high school seniors.

Each of the organizations awards three (3) scholarships to eligible seniors who have, beyond the norm, demonstrated leadership in promoting intergroup/intercultural relations and/or have through their actions, significantly reduced intergroup tension at their school and/or community.

Eligible students must have maintained a minimum 3.0 Grade Point Average, grades 9-12. The one-time scholarship of \$2,000 will be awarded to students upon submission of proof of enrollment in a college or university.

The Dr. Lawrence H. Moore Human Relations Scholarship will be awarded to students of our partner ethnic groups who have met this criteria. The naming of these scholarships is to honor Dr. Moore for his vision and dedication to promote better human relations within the Los Angeles Unified School District.
