Section H: Eligibility Requirements for the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., Beta Psi Lambda Scholarship

- Applicant must be an African-American male graduating from a high school in the greater Los Angeles area.
- **Applicant must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or greater.**
- Applicant must enroll in an accredited four-year college or university upon high school graduation.

Section I: REQUIREMENTS ** for the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., Beta Psi Lambda Scholarship

- The application must include an official copy of the most recent high school transcript (i.e. Fall semester)
- The application must include two letters of recommendation:
 - (1) from a teacher or high school administrator, and
 - (1) from a community representative /organization
- Applicant is required to provide a recent photograph no larger than 5x7 inches, and suitable for publication. The photo will not be returned.
- Applicant must be available for a personal interview with members of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., Beta Psi Lambda chapter IF selected as a finalist. Finalists' interviews are tentatively scheduled for the following Saturdays: **April 4, 2020 & April 18, 2020.**
- Final recipients must provide an official copy of their Fall 2020 enrollment verification prior to disbursement of scholarship award.
- **There will be a program honoring the 2020 Scholarship Recipients, tentatively scheduled for Saturday, June 13, 2020. All recipients are REQUIRED to be in attendance. Inability to attend the Scholarship Luncheon will result in award forfeiture.**
