## FAQ

1. What is the process for nominating a scholar?

A. Nominations are due on Friday, March 1, 2019. To nominate a student, you must be the designated representative from your school site authorized to nominate a student for the award. To nominate a student, visit: http://www.calfund.org/donors/warren-christopher-nomination/

- 2. Are all schools in L. A. Unified allowed to participate?
  - A. All L.A. Unified Schools and Affiliated Charter schools are eligible to participate.
- 3. If we have more than one school on a physical campus, can we submit more than one name?
  - A. Each school principal may submit one nomination.
    - If you are a school, with one or more magnets on the campus, with one principal, the principal under these schools has one nomination
    - If you are a school that shares the site with other schools that have different principals, each principal will have one nomination.
- 4. What is the process for a scholar to apply? Applications are due on Friday, March 29, 2019. The scholarship application will be accepted at: <a href="www.applyforgrants.calfund.org">www.applyforgrants.calfund.org</a>. - 5. Does a student need a social security number to apply?
  - A. No, the application does not require the submission of a social security number nor is citizenship or permanent residency a requirement for the scholarship.
- 6. Can an undocumented student apply?

- A. Yes, you may nominate a student who is undocumented so long as the meet the stated criteria for the scholarship.
- 7. What if a student doesn't have access to a computer to submit the application?
  - A. If a student does not have reasonable access to a computer through their home or school site, please contact CCF Scholarships at <a href="mailto:scholarships@calfund.org">scholarships@calfund.org</a> for a paper version of the application.
- 8. For students that are planning to attend college oversees, are they eligible for the award?
  - A. Unfortunately, the California Community Foundation is unable to issue scholarship awards to Colleges/Universities overseas. International universities are excluded because international privacy laws prohibit that students share pertinent information that is required in order for CCF to issue an award. Students studying abroad through a sponsored program via a domestic college (Ex. Study abroad programs sponsored by UCLA) may apply their scholarship to fees associated with studying abroad.
