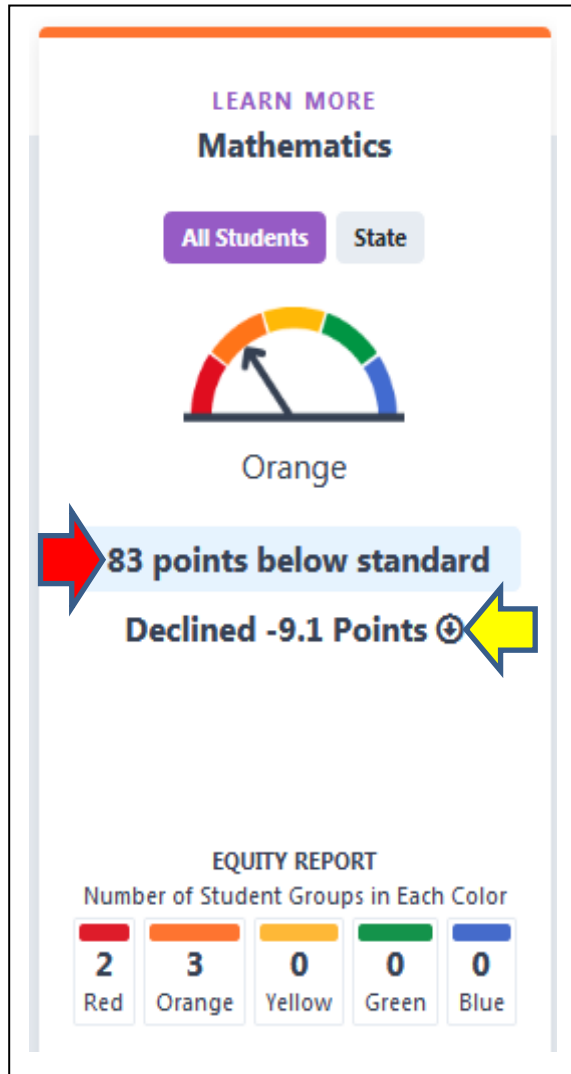

Here Now → Goal

According to the 2018 CA Dashboard, “All Students” in Mathematics are **83 points below standard** placing them in the “orange”. To move from “orange” to “yellow” by the 2019 CA Dashboard, “All Students” in Mathematics will **increase by 10 points** with “All Students” **increasing to 73 points below standard**.

According to the 2018 CA Dashboard in Mathematics, the African American subgroup and Students with Disabilities subgroups are **115.6 and 178 points below standard** placing them in the “red”. To move from “red” to “orange” by the 2019 CA Dashboard, both subgroups in Mathematics will **increase by 10 points increasing to 105.6 (African American) and 168 points (Students with Disabilities) below standard.**

- Subgroup has five or more indicators in red

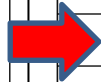

Criteria for CSI: (Examining “All Students” Row on Chart)

*Only needs to meet one of the following criteria

- High Schools with 67% or lower 3-yr. average graduation rate
- “All Students” has all red indicators on the dashboard
- “All Students” has all red with one of any other color
- “All Students” has a combination of all red and orange
- “All Students” has five or more indicators with majority in red

Requirements for a CSI School’s SPSA:

- Address all “reds” and “oranges” in the corresponding section of the SPSA
- Complete Addendum to SPSA:
 - Resource Inequities Review
 - Research-Based Intervention

Based on the first row for “All Students”, this school qualifies as a CSI School. (All red and orange)
