




#### How To Use "All Students" Data To Identify a School's Measurable Objective

According to the 2018 CA Dashboard, "All Students" in Mathematics are 83 points below standard placing them in the "orange". To move from "orange" to "yellow" by the 2019 CA Dashboard, "All Students" in Mathematics will increase by 10 points with "All Students" increasing to 73 points below standard.

According to the 2018 CA Dashboard in Mathematics, the African American subgroup and Students with Disabilities subgroups are 115.6 and 178 points below standard placing them in the "red". To move from "red" to "orange" by the 2019 CA Dashboard, both subgroups in Mathematics will increase by 10 points increasing to 105.6 (African American) and 168 points (Students with Disabilities) below standard.
