The Office of the Inspector General (OIG) looks forward to continuing our work of identifying and addressing matters of Fraud, Waste, Abuse and Employee Misconduct. With a fiscal year budget of \$14.3 billion and 63,000 employees in service of over 1,300 schools and centers at the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD), it is only with strategic focus of the OIG's limited resources that a substantive impact can be delivered.

The OIG strategy for the period from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2022 rests on the following three (3) primary goals:

Goal I – Deliver Oversight with Quality Audit and Investigative Services

- Conduct thorough and competent investigations to hold all actors accountable
- Continually enhance the quality of products through evaluation and feedback
