In order to fund one FTE within a discipline, individual schools are encouraged to pool their resources within their school families. Purchases will be processed in the order of receipt and are contingent on the availability of staff. It is the responsibility of the school to purchase/provide necessary supplies/textbooks for all arts instruction.
