## Background:

In the early 1500's the first African slaves were brought to the New World by the Spanish after attempts to enslave the natives failed. In 1619 a privateer ship, the White Lion, arrived in Jamestown with nearly 20 enslaved Africans that it acquired after raiding a Portuguese slave ship bringing the first slave to British North America. For nearly two hundred years millions more would be brought across the Middle Passage as the demand for labor rose in Colonial America.
