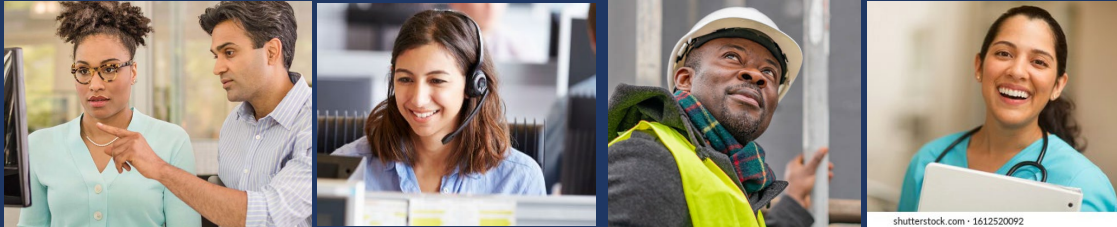




Announcing a Vacancy for Personnel Commissioner



The Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) is seeking a qualified individual to serve on its three-member Personnel Commission. Personnel Commissioners serve three-year terms and are responsible for establishing rules; approving class descriptions, salaries, and new classifications; and hearing disciplinary and examination appeals for the classified (non-teaching) service. Interested applicants must:

- reside within the territorial boundaries of the LAUSD
- be known adherents of merit system principles and known to be a person of good character
- be available to attend meetings held two days each month
- not be an LAUSD employee or a member of the LAUSD governing Board

Personnel Commissioners currently receive \$100 per meeting up to a \$500 monthly maximum, and medical benefits.
