

Quick Guide to Become a Virtual or On-Campus Volunteer in Los Angeles Unified

Fill out an application to volunteer at <https://volunteerapp.lausd.net/>. Select whether you would like to serve as a Virtual or On-Campus volunteer and select a school where you would like to serve.

Individuals interested in volunteering must check with the school administrator or designee regarding available Tier II and Tier III volunteer opportunities before submitting an application in the Volunteer Management System.

ON-CAMPUS VOLUNTEERS :

- Contact the school site to notify them that you have completed your application.
- Have your valid Tuberculosis (TB) clearance verification available.

VIRTUAL VOLUNTEERS:

- Contact the school site to notify them that you have completed your application.

The principal or site administrator will review the application and will approve based on need.

If the application is approved, the Office of Student, Family, and Community Engagement will conduct a final review of the application and confirm approval.

ON-CAMPUSVOLUNTEERS:

•After the Office of Student, Family, and Community Engagement approves your application, you will receive an email with a temporary badge good for 30 days. The official volunteer badge will be mailed to the school site.

VIRTUAL VOLUNTEERS:

•Opportunities to volunteer virtually are providing on and as-needed basis as identified by school administrator.
