Phase 1: PLANNING

- Create a collaboration plan
- Identify the working group
- Plan the meeting agenda

- Notify key educational personnel

Phase 2A

- Listen to the voices of partners throughout the District
- Identify key takeaways from the contributions

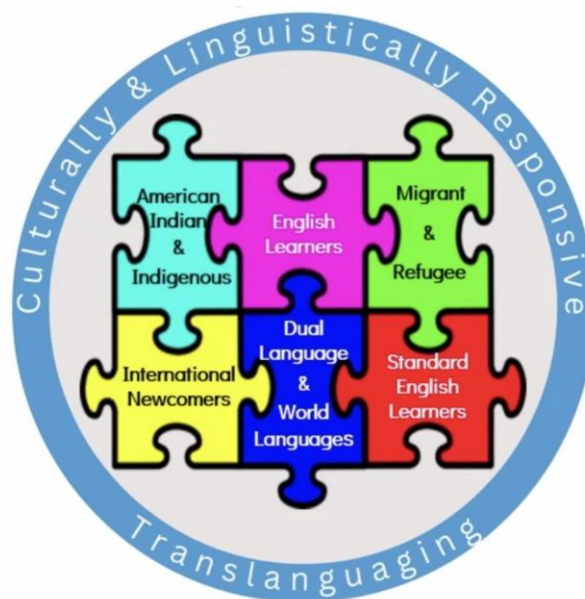
Phase 2B
