Why send a participant to the facilitator training?

This series of 5 full days of training helps participants to gain a deeper understanding of MLG and how to implement it effectively in the classroom. Participants will also be provided with time, deliberate practice, feedback, and resources that will equip them to lead school-site teams through the Mastery Learning and Grading PD series and build their capacity to support school-site implementation. Participants must have approval from their administrator to participate and school sites are responsible for providing sub coverage, if necessary.
