THE FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION PROCESS

Easy as 1-2-3!

1. COMPLETE THE FAFSA AT FAFSA.GOV OR DREAM ACT APPLICATION AT CALDREAMACT.ORG STARTING OCTOBER 1ST. FOR PRIORITY CONSIDERATION, APPLY BY MARCH 2ND*.
2. YOUR FAFSA OR DREAM ACT INFO IS ADDED TO MYGATEWAY. YOU MUST COMPLETE YOUR FILE IN ORDER TO HAVE YOUR ELIGIBILITY ESTABLISHED.
3. SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS (SAP) AND AWARD STATUS CAN BE VIEWED IN MYGATEWAY. REMEMBER TO CHECK MYGATEWAY REGULARLY FOR IMPORTANT UPDATES.
