COVID-19 Testing: Who Can Get Tested








The testing process is simple:

- 1. Make an appointment online.
- 2. A quick-check-in upon arrival at the site.
- 3. The test is free and the process takes less than 10 minutes, from start to finish.
- 4. Test results within 24-36 hours via text and email.




Wear your mask, socially distance and wash your hands to prevent the spread of COVID-19.


