How to Prepare for a Return to In-Person

Schedule Your Child's Test

- * Baseline COVID tests no earlier than a week prior to school opening
- * Students will be tested weekly at schools. Once parents give consent, no further action is needed.
- * Free testing is available for students, families and staff at 43 school-based testing centers
- * Testing center hours will be expanded starting April 5th from 7a.m. - 7 p.m.


