### How to Prepare for a Return to In-Person

### Schedule Your Child's Test

- \* Baseline COVID tests no earlier than a week prior to school opening
- \* Students will be tested weekly at schools. Once parents give consent, no further action is needed.
- \* Free testing is available for students, families and staff at 43 school-based testing centers
- \* Testing center hours will be expanded starting April 5th from 7a.m. - 7 p.m.

If School Start Date Baseline Test Must be taken between

April 12, 2021 - April 5 - April 11

April 19, 2021 April 12 - April 18

April 26, 2021 April 19 - April 25


