SUBJECT: 2025-26 SCHOOL BUDGET DEVELOPMENT PLANNING

The purpose of this communication is to share pertinent dates and information in preparation for the 2025-26 budget development period. Please note that budget development is occurring earlier than in prior years. An earlier timeline will enhance the district's ability to plan in alignment with State statutes and provide the Board of Education with additional data during the district budget approval process. This alignment will also support schools by alleviating the number of tasks required of school sites during the Spring.

Throughout the year, school administrators should be meeting with their applicable advisory committee(s) and School Site Council to discuss student needs, data and progress. In addition, school administrators are to hold an Annual School Goals and Budget Consultation Session to engage their community-at-large in learning about data, needs assessment, and the budget development process. It is highly encouraged that during these meetings budgeted priorities be established to support transparency and communication with stakeholders regarding how a change in funds would be invested (e.g. norm day true-up that results in additional dollars).

These meetings should occur prior to the Budget Development appointment, and verification of these meetings is to be completed in the Principal Portal. To better facilitate the budgeting process, please complete and bring the following documents to the Budget Development appointment:

- 1. Signed School Budget Signature Forms for each program code
- 2. 2025-26 School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) that describes the actions/tasks and costs
- 3. SPSA Budget Summary Page

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- 4. Signed Employee Roster Letter
- 5. Manual Budget Adjustment Requests indicating positions funded with grants
- 6. Teacher Assistant Reduction-In-Force HR Form 5009 for teacher assistant positions that will not be funded in 2025-26
- 7. Alternate Staffing Pattern (ASP) request form for schools that currently have ASP in place

In addition, modules were developed to assist school-site leaders with hosting advisory committee, School Site Council and community-at-large meetings.
