SUBJECT: REPURPOSING MIDDLE SCHOOL COLLEGE AND CAREER COACH FUNDING IN THE 2025-2026 SCHOOL YEAR

The purpose of this correspondence is to provide information regarding the sunset of the Middle School College and Career Coach (MSCCC) position for the 2025-2026 school year. The funding for the MSCCC will be repurposed to support the expansion of the Middle School Interventionist Program.

Background

During the 2024-2025 school year, 121 middle schools received Title I funding at levels of 100%, 50%, or 33% to support the MSCCC program. Of these, 102 schools utilized the funding to create full-time MSCCC positions.

Reallocation of Title I Funds

For the 2025-2026 school year, Title I funds will be redirected to strengthen the Middle School Literacy Interventionist Program. As such, Priority middle schools will continue to receive full-time Literacy Interventionists. Additionally, Title I middle/span schools with at least 50 students not meeting standards, as measured by the Spring 2024 SBA English Language Arts, will receive a full-time Literacy Interventionist (Attachment A). This expansion aims to increase foundational literacy support.
