Secondary Start Smart 2.0 Conversation Practices

This is a one-day professional development for secondary Designated ELD (dELD) teachers on the new Start Smart 2.0 Lessons. These lessons build on the Constructive Conversation Skills and Norms previously taught in Start Smart 1.0.

Participants will:

- Understand the structure and content of the Secondary Start Smart 2.0 lessons including the conversation pattern, language protocols and digital lessons
- Deepen their understanding of the Constructive Conversation Skills and how they address the ELD standards, ELA/ELD Framework and ELPAC language demands
- Use formative assessment tools to capture evidence of student progress in the CA ELD standards and make connections to the ELPAC tasks
