Apply to Become a National Board Teacher

Have you been interested in pursuing NBC Certification but the cost has been an obstacle for you? Review the steps to see if you are eligible to apply for certification and the state subsidy.

Step 1) Visit the NBPTS website to review the NBC eligibility requirements.

Step 2) Review the window to apply on the CDE website.

Step 3) Review the 2024–2025 High Priority Schools List to see if your school is eligible. <https://www.cde.ca.gov/ci/pl/documents/highpriorityschools24-25.xlsx>

Step 4) You must first [register for an account with NBPTS](#) prior to applying for the subsidy award. There is no cost to create an account.

Step 5) Complete the 2024–25 Subsidy Application

The [2024–25 NBPTS Candidate Subsidy Application](#) opens September 3, 2024.

This application is for new and continuing teachers in the process of pursuing a certification from NBPTS when teaching at a school on the Eligible High-Priority Schools List after July 1, 2024. There are two windows for 2024–25 **applicants:**

Early Bird Application Window 1: Open September 3, 2024, through October 31, 2024 at 4 p.m.

Application Window 2: Open November 7, 2024, through January 10, 2025 at 4 p.m.

For new applicants: You must first [register for an account with NBPTS](#) prior to applying for the subsidy award. There is no cost to create an account.

Applicants will be asked to provide your candidate ID in the subsidy application. Subsidy applications with an invalid candidate ID will be rejected and applicants will be required to re-apply for the subsidy award.
