

Immigrants and Public Benefits



Are you worried about how using government benefits will affect your immigration status?

Here's what you should know about public charge:

- NO CHANGES have been made to how getting public benefits affects your immigration status if you are already in the United States.
- If the rule changes in the future, you will have at least 60 DAYS to find out if the new rule affects you.
- Many of the public benefits **YOUR CHILDREN** get will not affect YOUR immigration status.
- For many groups of immigrants, getting public benefits has NO EFFECT on their immigration status.
- Fules about how getting public benefits affects your immigration status are complicated. SPEAK TO AN ATTORNEY before cancelling government benefits that you and your children need.
