
## Step 1: Log onto the MyPGS Platform





**Step 4:** Access your **Teacher Self-Assessment:** The Self-Assessment is the first step in the EDST, and offers you the opportunity to reflect on strengths and opportunities for improving practice. This reflection is based on the Focus Elements of the Teaching and Learning Framework, and will inform appropriate objectives and activities on the Initial Planning Sheet.
