## **Assessments** will include:

- Daily formative measures of class participation in individual and group work, and periodic quizzes.
- Performance-based activities; interviews, classroom oral and written assessments (the Classroom Oral Competency Interview (COCI), and the Classroom Writing Competency Assessment (CWCA), periodic
