

The framework allows the Board to assess...




Whether budget **line items** are **aligned** to measurable student **outcomes**



Whether expenditures represent a coherent* strategy

*Coherence means that any line item in a budget should be consistent and coordinated with other items, the goals of other investments, and District and state priorities.
