## 2 MORE THAN A MEAL CAMPAIGN

The More Than A Meal (MTAM) Campaign has been successful in helping Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) schools in the collection of Household Income Forms (HIFs).

CEP Schools are supported by a MTAM Liaison throughout the school year in the collection of completed HIFs.

## **CEP=Community Eligibility Provision**

All students at CEP schools are eligible for free meals regardless of family income.

CEP schools submit completed Household Income Forms (HIFs) to generate additional TSP (Targeted Student Population) school funds.

Household Income Forms (HIFs) are to be collected only for students who are new to LAUSD during the school year.

# For 2021-2022- NEW CEP Schools to be Added




For School Year 2021-2022, some current "Pricing Schools" will be converted to "CEP Schools".

Schools converting to "CEP" will be notified in July 2021 and will be required to collect Household Income Forms (HIFs), not Meal Applications.

Designated responsibility to collect HIFs is to the school's office staff, not the Cafeteria Manager.

A MTAM Liaison will support CEP schools throughout the school year in the collection of completed HIFs.

# Online HIFs – Fast & Easy

For students listed on the MTAM Dashboard as HIF missing, school staff should call the parent and assist with completion of the Online HIF.

Household Income Forms (HIFs) can be completed online <a href="https://hif.lausd.net using a computer or cell phone">https://hif.lausd.net using a computer or cell phone</a>.

Online HIFs are the fastest and easiest way for parents to submit HIFs for one or multiple children in the family, even if siblings are enrolled at different schools.

## HIFs = Extra School TSP Funds




Each completed HIF submitted by the deadline brought in an <u>average of \$1,024 per student in TSP funds directly</u> to the individual LD West CEP schools for the 2021-2022 school year.

The amount of individual school TSP funding per student ranges from a high of \$1,893 per student to a low of \$500 per student, depending on the school level, size, and a formula based on student categories.

HIFs not submitted by Friday, June 25, 2021, mean LOST TSP funding for those CEP schools for multiple years.

# LD West MTAM Teams Earn TSP Monies for 2021-2022



Because of the efforts of the LD West MTAM Teams in submitting HIFs by the deadline, LD West CEP schools were allocated TSP funds totaling \$39,357,409 for the 2021-2022 school year. Wow!

# 2020-2021 HIF Deadline

Beginning today, contact your school's MTAM Liaison, Manuel Diaz or Sue Spears, to arrange for pick-up and delivery of completed HIFs to the Student Record Center. This ensures that the completed HIFs are received by the deadline of Friday, June 25, 2021, to qualify for school TSP funding.

Continue to call the parents of students listed on the MTAM Dashboard as HIF missing and assist the parents with completion of the Online HIF.

## For Next School Year 2021-2022

As students enroll for the 2021-2022 school year who are new to LAUSD, have parents complete the yellow Household Income Form (HIF) or complete the Online HIF now.

Do not mail the completed yellow HIFs until after school starts next semester on August 17, 2021.

After August 17, 2021, mail the completed yellow HIFs to Student Record Center – LD East – Attn. Mark Dominguez.

No HIF is necessary for students enrolling or matriculating from another LAUSD school.

## LAUSD Goal is 100% HIF Submission

The District has set a goal of 100% HIF submission for every CEP school. HIFs missing and incomplete by the deadline of June 25, 2021, result in lost school TSP monies for multiple school years.

We are here to help LD West CEP schools in meeting the District's HIF submission goal of 100%.
