DeltaCare USA gives you comprehensive and affordable dental coverage from a large network of high-quality and rigorously vetted dentists. In most states, you'll choose a general dentist who performs your exams and cleanings, and they will refer you to specialists for more advanced procedures if you need them.

However, if you live in some states, you don't have to choose a general dentist first, and you don't have to get a referral to see a specialist. These states, called open access states, are AK, CT, LA, ME, MS, MT, NC, ND, NH, OK, SD, VT and WY.

Here are some important things to know about DeltaCare USA if you live in one of these states:

- You can visit any DeltaCare USA dentist.
 Just make an appointment and pay your copayments¹ for each service as laid out in your plan documents.
- You don't have to select a general dentist.

- You don't need a referral to visit a specialist.
- Since you have the flexibility to see any DeltaCare USA provider without prior authorization, you can see any dentist in your state in case of emergency.
- You must visit DeltaCare USA dentists in your state only.
- If you see a dentist outside the DeltaCare USA network, you may have to pay additional out-of-pocket fees. If you live in Wyoming, you do not have out-of-network benefits.²
