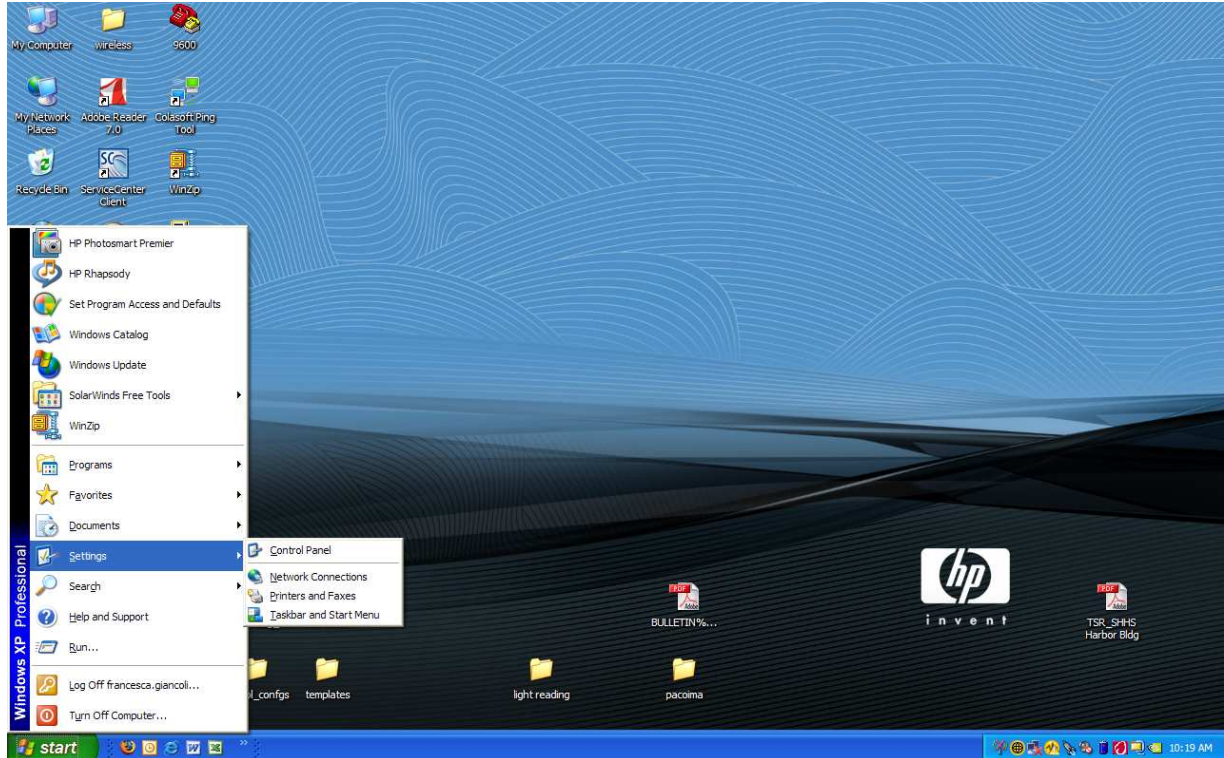
**Step 1: Find – Network and Internet Connections**  
There are 3 ways to open **My Network Places** or **Network Connections**

- a. From the desktop, Right-mouse-click – **My Network Places**  
Select **Properties**



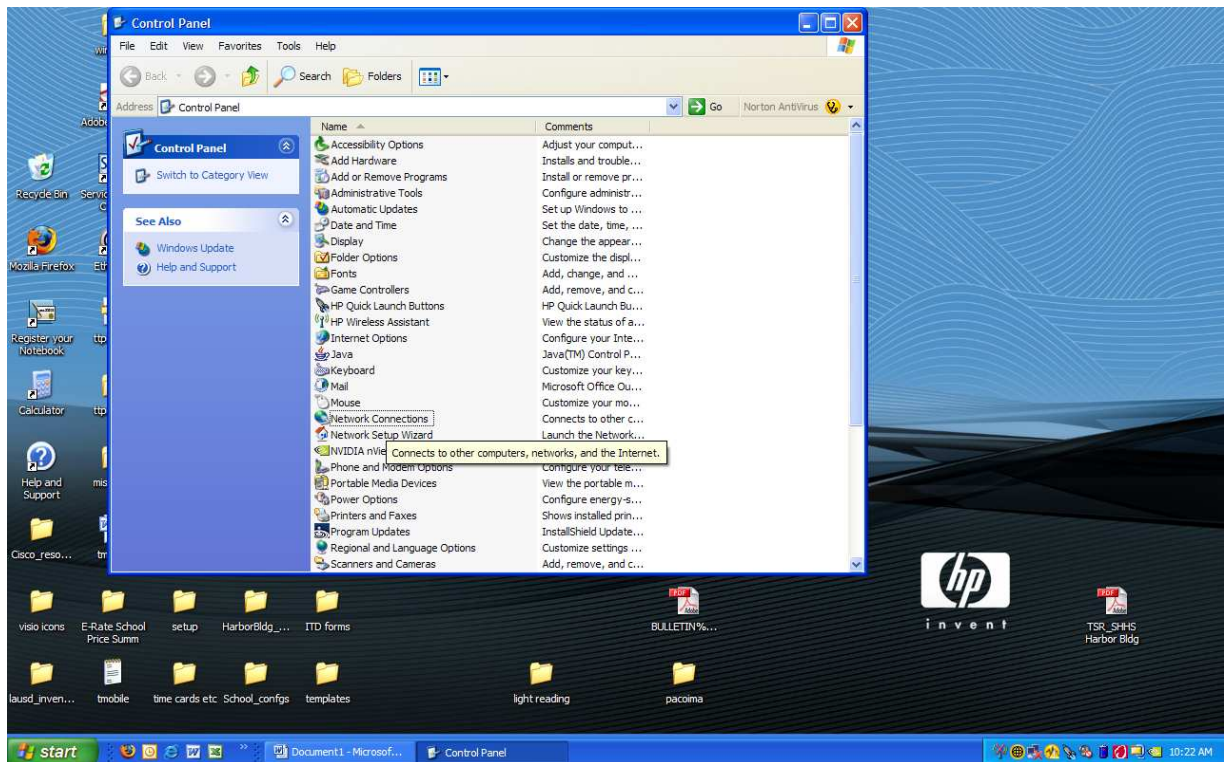
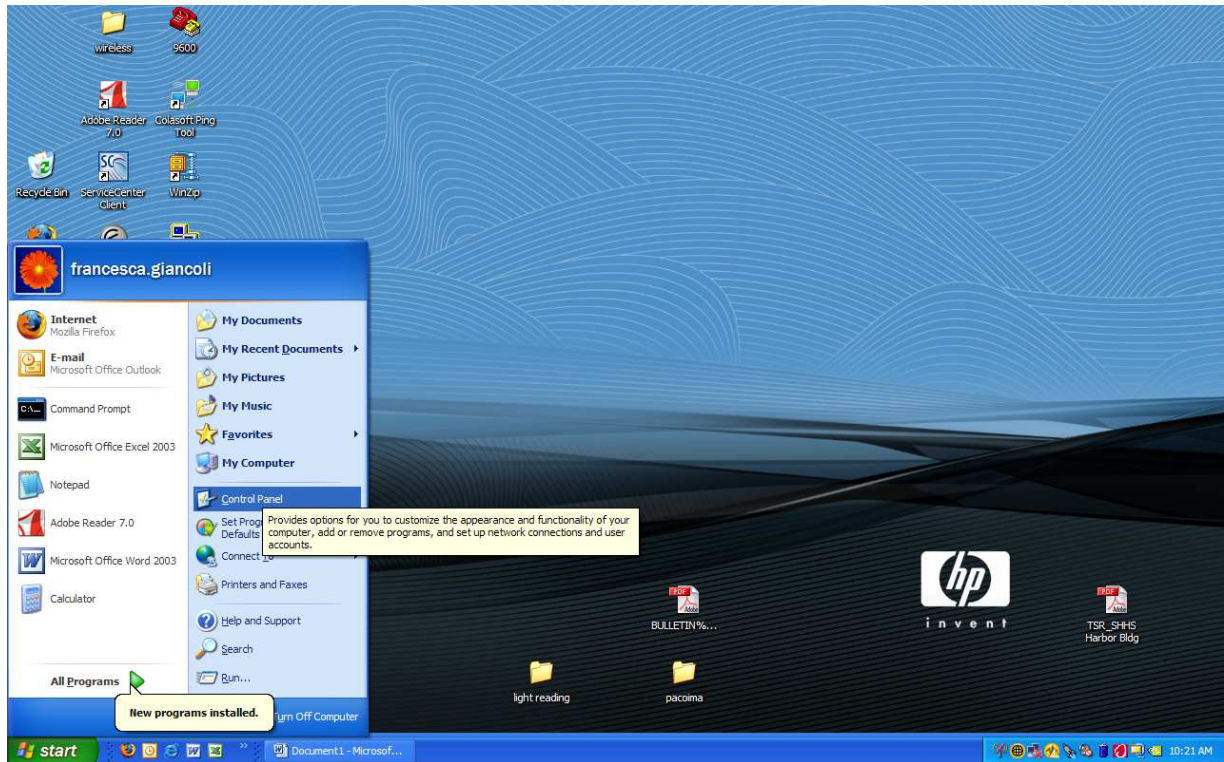

b. From the Start menu, Settings, Select to Open – **Network Connections**

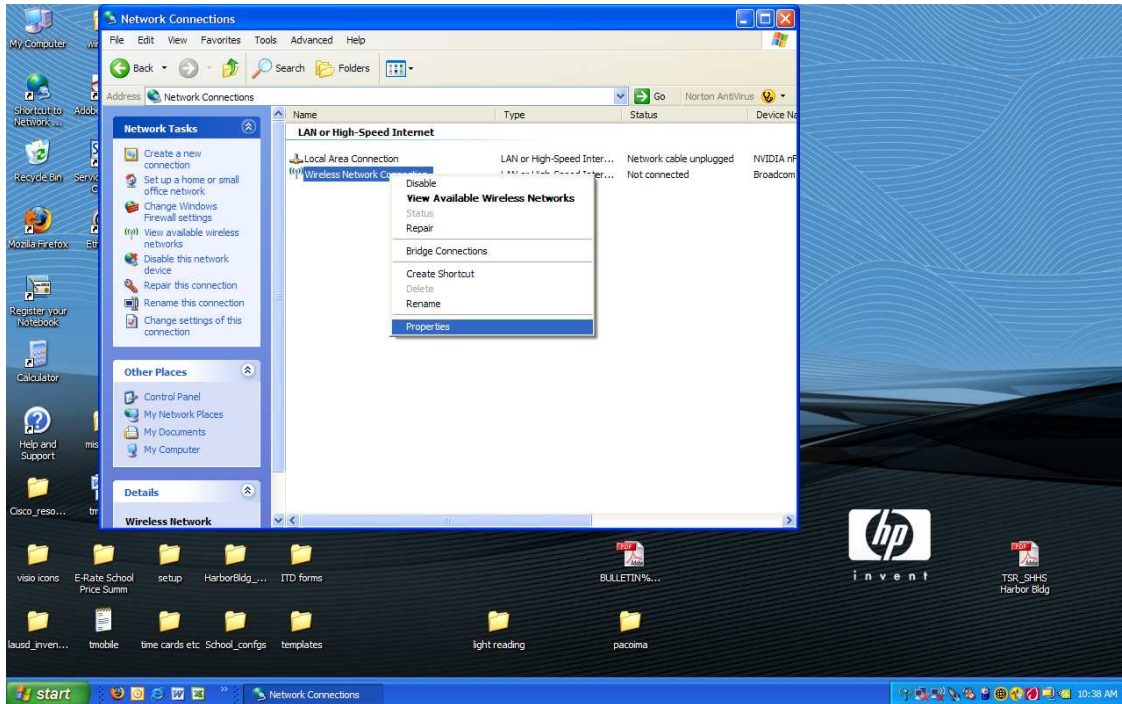

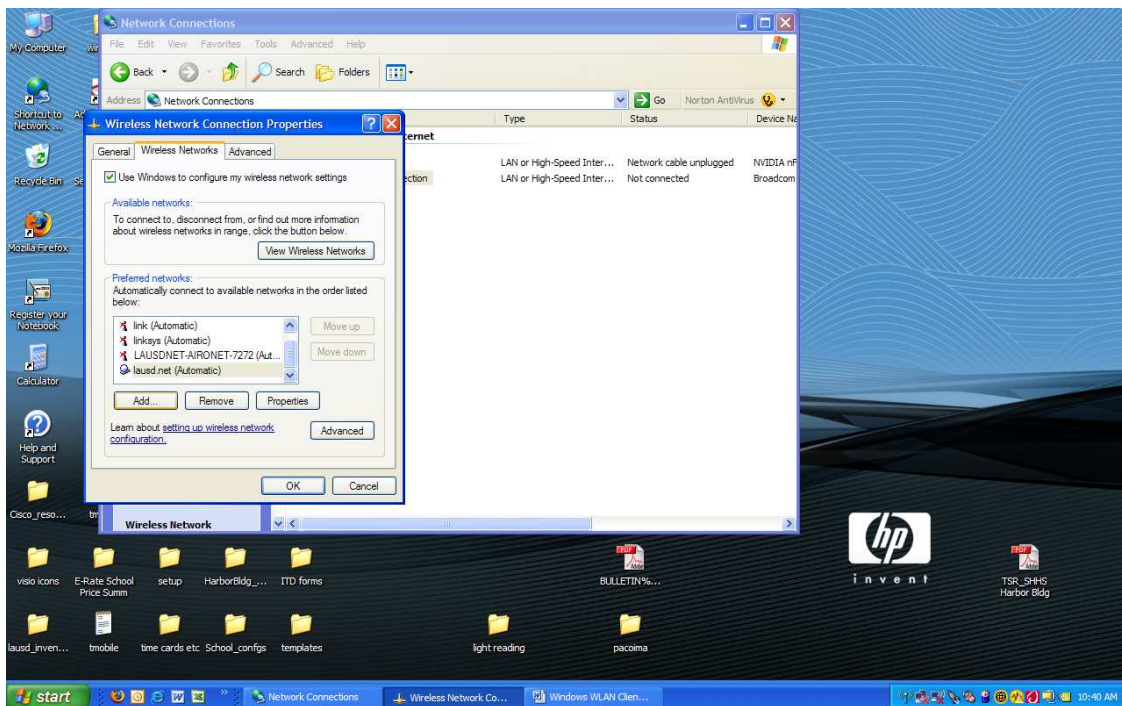
- c. From the Start menu, Select to Open **Control Panel**,  
Double-left-mouse-click to Open – **Network Connections**



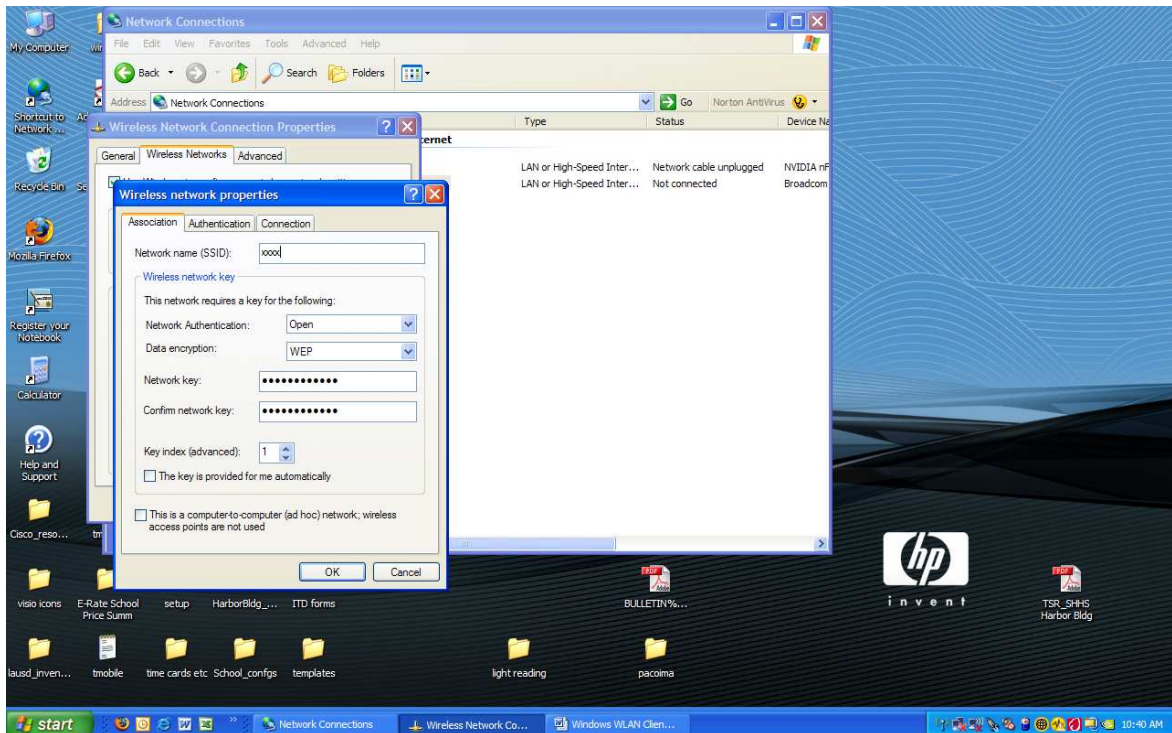
**Step 2: Right-mouse-click – Wireless Network Connections, Select Properties**



**Step 3: Select – the Wireless Networks Tab and Select – Add in the Preferred Networks section**



- Step 4:** Enter the SSID supplied to you by ITD.  
**Network Authentication** should be **Open** (default)  
**Data Encryption** should be **WEP** (default)  
Uncheck the box next to **“The key is provided for me automatically”** and enter the Network (WEP) key supplied by ITD in both **Network key** boxes to confirm.  
Select **OK** in both windows.  
Your laptop will connect in a few seconds and you can test it by attempting to browse a website.  
Your laptop will also automatically connect whenever you are on campus and within range of one of the wireless access points.



**NOTE: DO NOT Distribute the SSID or WEP key to any unauthorized persons.**
