SENIOR HAND GRADER

DEFINITION

Provides work direction and participates in performing tasks involved in the grading, resurfacing, and leveling of paved areas.

TYPICAL DUTIES

Provides work direction to a small asphalt repair crew and performs manual work in:

Breaking up old asphalt and removing it from area to be repaved

Preparing subgrades and filling low spots in surfacing

Cleaning areas where new asphalt is to be joined to existing surfacing

Placing emulsion as a sealing substance for asphalt surfacing

Using crack filler in areas where resurfacing is not warranted

Spreading surfacing materials

Operating an air compressor, concrete cutting saw, and related equipment

Hand grading and leveling surfaces

Cleaning work areas and loading debris for disposal

Setting headers and preparing for finish grade.

Contacts the Paving Supervisor for technical advice.

Contacts school personnel regarding repair requests and permission to start work and to bring a truck and equipment onto school grounds.

Checks amount and quality of work performed.

Supervises the use and care of vehicles, tools, and equipment at the work site.

Dispatches vehicles for additional surfacing materials as necessary.

Performs related duties as assigned.

DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS AMONG RELATED CLASSES

A Senior Hand Grader leads a small repair crew in the manual tasks involved in grading, resurfacing, and leveling of paved areas on school grounds, and schedules each repair at a site.

A Senior Tractor and Roller Operator plans work projects and supervises one or more crews in grading, surfacing, and maintaining school paved areas and occasionally operates heavy equipment used in such work.

A Hand Grader performs manual tasks involved in the grading, resurfacing, leveling, and smoothing of school grounds.

SUPERVISION

General supervision is received from a Senior Tractor and Roller Operator and the Paving Supervisor. Work direction is exercised over employees in the class of Hand Grader.

CLASS QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge of:

Grading and surfacing of school grounds
Safety regulations and practices related to asphalt paving

Ability to:

Provide work direction to a small crew of employees performing asphalt paving duties Use and care for tools and equipment used in grading and surfacing work Estimate time and material costs of grading and paving work Work effectively with school personnel and the public Read simple plans and sketches

ENTRANCE QUALIFICATIONS

Education:

Graduation from high school or equivalent evidence of educational proficiency at the high school level.

Experience:

One year of experience in asphalt paving, repair, or related work.

Special:

A valid driver's license to legally operate a motor vehicle in the State of California and use of a motor vehicle.
